

Call for Entries – *The Art of Action*

***The Art of Action* Call Description**

58 Main, a pop-up event venue in the heart of downtown Bangor, will be hosting a silent auction of art to benefit the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU). This juried art show is open to all artists living, working or with roots in Maine. All media will be considered as long as the art is designed and created by the applicant. The deadline for entries is March 12, 2017 or until the gallery space has been allotted.

*As an applicant, please recognize that your submission represents a donation. The purchase price of all works will be donated entirely to the ACLU. Minimum bids will be employed and items that fail to reach the minimum value will be returned to the artist (although we hope this doesn't happen). The show organizers will use the utmost care in the handling of all pieces, but they are not responsible for any damages incurred.

Entry Instructions

Each applicant may submit up to two pieces of work to be included in the jury process. Depending on the number of entries, only one piece of work may be selected for the auction. Each applicant must submit a digital image (requirements below) and specify the size and materials. Framing or matting is strongly preferred when applicable.

Image Submissions File Format

Please submit one unenhanced digital JPEG image of 2-D artwork (two images for 3-D artwork). Each JPEG image shall not exceed 5MB in file size and should show the work in completed form.
